An **Empty Bottle** report Offers Same Old Wine

Orwellian approach Can't Even "Relieve" Congestion

Keep NYC Free reveals another truth about the <u>regressive</u> Fix NYC "Zone Pricing" <u>scheme</u>: When it comes to addressing congestion, according to the new Fix NYC document, it does nothing compared to other cities where those jurisdictions report substantial reductions. The report harps on a 9% increase in taxi speeds (see next two pages) in a shameful intent to sell the <u>same old wine</u> in an empty new bottle. Let's *Look at the Record*: Average taxi speeds per the report range from 4.7 mph ("midtown core") to 6.8 mph (CBD aka Central Business District). Simple math indicates respective "increases" of 0.42 mph & 0.6 mph. State Senator Leroy Comrie raised the negligible outcome in <u>comments</u> at an Albany hearing yesterday (at 3:52 "...it doesn't relieve congestion..."

Rather than this toll-tax <u>scheme</u> that fails our <u>economy</u> and <u>ignores</u> the facts that drivers of private vehicles already pay registration fees and surcharges, gas taxes and sales taxes on repairs and purchases, Keep NYC recommends sustainable approaches it <u>identified</u> to realize the necessary resources.

Look at the revenue <u>reforms</u> Keep NYC Free and others <u>recommend</u>. As Jimmy <u>Messina</u> poses in song with Kenny <u>Loggins</u> in the <u>Same Old Wine</u>, *Can we trust in new directions When their promises are in disguise*.

FIGURE 1. Average Taxi Speeds in Manhattan CBD and the Midtown Core 2010-2016




	FIGURE 12. ESTIMATED ZONE FEE GROSS REVENUE (ASSUMES ONCE PER DAY) (IN \$MILLIONS)
