Queens Residents Zone Out Congestion Pricing

A poll of registered Democratic voters from the Borough of Queens strong opposition to the unsustainable, unfair, inequitable and regressive toll-tax scheme known as Congestion Pricing. The *Exclusive Queens Tribune*-commissioned poll surveyed likely (Queens) Democratic voters in the Thursday, September 13, 2018 Primary.
