

The MTA did not factor the Congestion Tax into its 2008 budget

The MTA's website includes FAQs (frequently asked questions) on its proposed fare hike.

One question was:

How does the Congestion Pricing Initiative play into your Financial Plan proposal?

The MTA answer summarized, in two words:

It wouldn't.

The answer started,

In a best case, congestion pricing wouldn't begin providing revenue until 2010, so it did not factor into the 2008 budget.
