STATEMENT ON FIRM STATEWIDE OPPOSITION TO CONGESTION PRICING TAX BY KEEP NYC CONGESTION TAX FREE

"By an overwhelming margin, New York Democrats, Republicans, and independents oppose reinstatement of the \$15 Congestion Pricing Tax plan, according to a <u>Siena College Research Institute survey</u> released today. This latest poll demonstrates exactly what we're hearing and seeing across political lines: A Congestion Pricing Tax would be unfair, unaffordable, regressive, and economically counterproductive. Sixty-eight percent (68%) of Republicans, fifty-six percent (56%) of Democrats, and fifty-four percent (54%) of independents support Governor Kathy Hochul's decision to shelve the controversial plan, which would have done nothing to improve overall city traffic and which would have increased air pollution in low-income communities.
