On Election Day New Yorkers and the nation sent a message loud and clear, affordability and inflation are chief among the concerns of voters. Indeed the results on Tuesday evidence that New Yorkers overwhelmingly reject inflationary and regressive economic policies like Congestion Pricing (Polls show support only 23% of New Yorkers including many mercenaries for hedge-funder financed groups.). It's no wonder that the Democratic Party experienced dramatic shift in electoral results, drawing less support – some 500,000 fewer votes for President in the city and 800,000 fewer statewide. The last thing New York needs and New Yorkers want is to increase our cost of living more and make things even less affordable.
